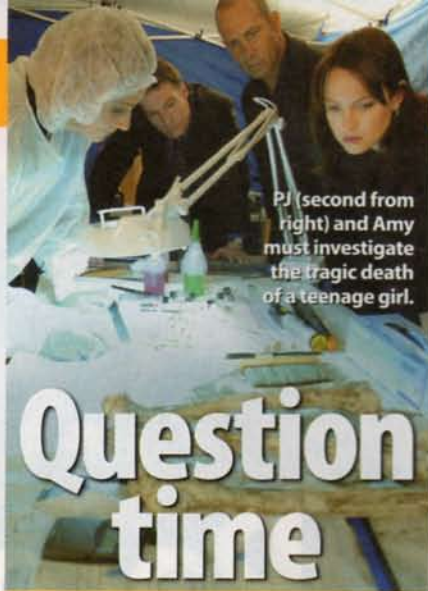
"With Kerry, there has always been a spark and they haven't really had to work at it," Paul says.
