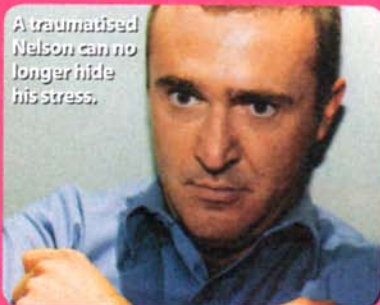


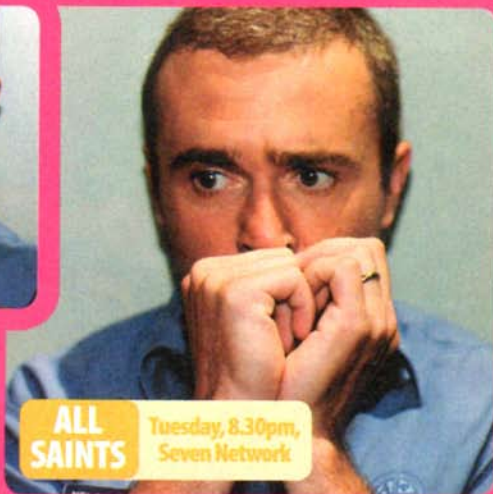
A traumatised Nelson can no longer hide his stress.
